General Painting Supplies

- Grey graphite
- White graphite
- Palette knife - for mixing values of paint
- Stylus
- Tracing Paper
- Wax Palette - for mixing
- Wet Palette - for keeping paint moist while you are painting
- Water container
- Paper towels

Surface

3" x 5" canvas I have these and will sell for \$1 each

Brushes

3/4" Wash
#6 flat or filbert
#0 or #1 liner
Mops
Scrubby brush

Paint

2 Colors:

1. Tube acrylic in whatever color you would like your painting to be. My examples are Burnt Umber and Paynes Grey
2. White tube acrylic

You will need a toothpick size dot of Cad Yellow.
