#### DecoArt Americana Acrylics

Black, Payne's grey, midnite blue, uniform blue, winter blue, Snow White, warm white, bleached sand, buttermilk, burlap, marigold and burnt Sienna.

#### Supplies

Ultra fine permanent black marker Blending medium Saran Wrap Star stencil

#### Brushes

Round brush size 2 Angular shader 1/4" Normal brushes

blending medium and using Saran Wrap for design on background. The design will be zentangled at the end. The basecoating won't be too time consuming either. We will get through this all together unless you decide to use a different surface.
