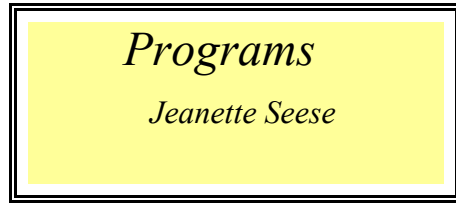

Programs--- In January we will have a class of acrylic pouring by Rhonda Norton. Rhonda has provided a list of materials you will need to participate. Here is the information she would like you to know.... (also for your convenience it is on the last page of this Newsletter for you to print out)

I'm so excited to be teaching acrylic pouring in January! Here's what you need to bring....Acrylic paint (any brand). White (a new 2oz bottle) as we will use quite a bit. Black, any gold metallic you like and 4-6 other colors (pick your favorites, have a couple of darks, metallic colors are nice too). Surfaces.... any flat surface 8x10 or smaller. Please bring in at least 4-6 surfaces as I will be teaching different techniques and pouring is addicting! You can bring in the same surface or mix them to see what you like working on! Canvas (put on one or two coats of gesso), MDF, or Wood please seal and gesso (one or two coats of gesso) if using canvas panels you will need to put 3 coats of gesso on the back along with two coats on the front or they will curl..... Tiles (from home depot) and Yupo. If you bring Tiles and/or Yupo do not gesso or seal. Shallow box lined with plastic or disposable aluminum foil baking pan larger than your surface (paint will be dripping into this). Popsicle sticks (few for each color), pallet knife, roll of cheap paper towels, baby wipes, masking or painters tape, Apron or smock. Boxes or containers to put your finished Wet work in for the drive home. Paintings take a long time to dry and need to stay flat.

*p.s. If you have a Heat gun please bring it (extension cord would be helpful). I'm also looking for plastic squeeze bottles for your white paint mixture. (Anything under 8oz. Is great). Thank you and see you in January.

As of this date, there is no program planned for February. If you wish to teach in February, please email Jeanette. Also email if you wish to teach in any other months.

At the January meeting she will discuss further programs and take suggestions for classes that you would like to see. Please think about what you want for this next year.

Since we are no longer part of SDP, we can be a little more lenient with the type of presentations, if that is your desire!

January 6, 2018 Workshop
THE ART OF POURING
with Rhonda Norton

Material list:

Acrylic paint (any brand):

White (a new 2oz bottle) as we will use quite a bit.

Black

Any gold metallic you like

4-6 other colors (pick your favorites, have a couple of darks, metallic colors are nice too).

Surfaces.... any flat surface 8x10 or smaller.

Please bring in at least 4-6 surfaces as I will be teaching different techniques and pouring is addicting!

You can bring in the same surface or mix them to see what you like working on!

Canvas (put on one or two coats of gesso)

MDF, or Wood please seal and gesso (one or two coats of gesso)

If using canvas panels you will need to put 3 coats of gesso on the back along with two coats on the front or they will curl.....

*Tiles (from home depot)

*Yupo.

**If you bring Tiles and/or Yupo do not gesso or seal.

Other stuff:

Shallow box lined with plastic or disposable aluminum foil baking pan larger than your surface (paint will be dripping into this).

Popsicle sticks (few for each color)

Pallet knife

Roll of cheap paper towels

Baby wipes

Masking or painters tape

Apron or smock.

Boxes or containers to put your finished Wet work in for the drive home. Paintings take a long time to dry and need to stay flat.

PS: If you have a Heat gun please bring it (extension cord would be helpful).
I'm also looking for plastic squeeze bottles for your white paint mixture.
(Anything under 8oz. Is great).
