



Material list and Prep instructions....Portrait class with Darla Willhite

1/4 sheet (11x14 approx) w/c paper 300lb or 140lb

If using 140 lb. approx. 11x14 watercolor paper, tape it to a foam core board or something rigid.

In addition to regular brushes and paper towels, bring 2 large water buckets.

Darla will provide the paints and a foam plate for mixing colors.

If you want to use another medium, such as oils or acrylics, please bring your own supplies.

Use the line drawing to use as a pattern by enlarging it to 11x14 OR as a reference source to compare with your drawing on tracing paper using the black and white copy that was given out at the Feb. meeting.
