New Business: Beverly Brockschmidt stated that December 3rd is the date for the Christmas Party.


Show and Tell: Many beautiful items and various techniques were shown.

As a special request I would like to invite everyone who painted Darla's project to please bring their FINISHED project in for Show and Tell. It does not have to be framed.

Program for April:

We will have Pat Otto instructing "Preening Swan." It is in oil, and the list of supplies is listed at the end of this Newsletter. Pat distributed the patterns at the last class, and if you need a full size pattern, please contact Pat, since the pattern is too large to include in the Newsletter.

BUT please note:

After working up her instructions and painting her sample for the swan, Pat Otto has strongly suggested that some students do an 8 x 10 canvas. The 8 x 10 pattern is in this newsletter and also on our website www.naturecoastdecorativeartists.com. It is 50% of



16 x 20. She is concerned the slow or less experienced painters will get bogged down and become discouraged. It is not a hard project but may go slowly and need oversight because there are not a lot of well defined areas. Pat did an 8x10 sample and it came out very nice. She will be teaching that size because it fits under the camera and will be easier to follow. Students will have lots of photos to go by if they want to do a 16 x 20 later. Those who aren't afraid to tackle it full size are welcome to do so.

Coming in May:

We will have Jeanette Seese teaching Chinoiserie.

The pattern will be given out at the April meeting and will also appear in the May Newsletter. A wood surface of about 9-10" square or round is best.

Jeanette used a large hand mirror.

The paints she used were metallic powders in a kit, but they seem to be unavailable for purchase on the web. If you have an old set, you are in luck! If you don't, use the list of metallic paints provided in the May Newsletter.

Supply list for "Preening Swan" by Pat Otto 8X10 OR 16 x 20 canvas -

it is suggested that you have the pattern on before class.

Base coat water areas with Deco-Art Americana Victorian Blue or Delta Ceramcoat Aqua Blue.

Pat's sample was painted in oil Cerulean Blue. If you do not have the colors above see the TCS book and get as close as you can.

Having this prepped will make handling the canvas easier.

PLEASE NOTE: Pat will not be supplying a palette. An inexpensive set of oils can be purchased at Wal-Mart and the few colors that it is lacking may be mixed.

Oil Paint Colors Cerulean Blue,
Prussian Blue,
Titanium White,
Cadmium Orange,
Burnt Sienna,
Black,
Yellow Ochre
Alizarin Crimson

Mona Lisa Odorless thinner - available at Michael's. It is never on sale so you can use a coupon.

Brushes - Liner Brush- 1 inch, 3/4 inch 1/2 inch synthetic brushes optional large mop brush.

They do not have to be in good condition with the exception of the liner brush. Bring other brushes if you like them.

Other - Easel, paper towels, small container for thinner (such as a Gatorade cap), box to transport wet oil painting.
