


Programs Jeanette Seese

Cardinal Banner

Carolyn Bacon

Project is painted on canvas cloth 8x24 or anything approx size

Base the background Oyster Beige (Am) at least 2 coats then Tape the sides 1/4" from outside and paint Tuscan Red - lightly sand with sanding film or brown paper bag. When painting is finished and dry fold 2 1/4" from the top and glue to create a pocket for a dowel. The bottom can be folded back and glued or a thin piece piece of balsa wood glued to the back for weight.

Apply pattern

Base as follows:

Female bird - Slate Grey including beak and feet the branch she is sitting on is also slate grey

Leaves - Antique Green

Berries - Calico Red

Nest Branch - Milk Chocolate

Feather - Canyon Orange

Male Cardinal - Tuscan Red Face - Soft Black Beak Canyon Orange

Deep Burgandy

Lamp Black

Palette -

Yellow Light

Antique Maroon

White Fawn
Oyster Beige Soft Black
Tuscan Red Slate Grey
Antique Green Calico Red
Canyon Orange Burnt Umber
Raw Sienna Baby Blue

Napa Red Burnt Sienna
