

May 4, 2013: A Great White Heron.... a watercolor project taught by Renee Burton. Cost: \$5.00

Watercolors needed: Burnt Sienna. Cad Yellow Medium, Rose, Grumbacher Red, Hooker's Green, Turquoise, Ultramarine Blue, Indigo. Suggested Brands: Grumbacher, Sue Schewee, Cheap Joe's American Journey. Paper towels, watercolor palette, 2 water buckets, and a small bottle cap.


Bring your favorite brushes including a liner, rounds, 3/4 flat, and a 3/4 foliage brush are also needed. No oil brushes please. Acrylic brushes may be used, but be sure no paint is left in the ferrule.

PLUS one OLD #4 or #6 round!!!!!

The pattern is already on the watercolor paper, but you will need to apply maskit in the morning before the class. The chapter will supply the maskit. This is a

fun and beautiful project.

June 1, 2013: *Pink & Chocolate Hibiscus* taught in Acrylics by Jeanette Seese. Cost \$5.00 The picture, pattern, and all needed supplies are in The Decorative Painter Issue 1, 2013 on page 107. 


