GOLDEN ARTIST ACRYLIC FOR SEASHELL PROJECT

Burnt Sienna Burnt Umber Cadmium Yellow Light Carbon Black Cerulean Blue Chromium Oxide Green Napthol Red Light Titanium White Ultramarine Blue Yellow Oxide



USE YOUR CHOICE OF PAINT FOR THE BACKGROUND

These colors are not critical and you could paint the background whatever color you wish such as.....

Blackish/Very dark Green Aqua Blue - reminding you of the sea Sea Green

PLEASE NOTE - This project can also be painted with your bottle acrylics.

I WILL SELL A PALETTE OF GOLDEN ACRYLIC PAINT FOR \$7.00

The surface I used is a traditional wooden artist's palette. They can be ordered from Dick Blick, Jerry's Artarama, and other art catalogs. You might also find them at Michaels and Hobby Lobby. Or ordered from Lois Owens.

Or you can paint the design on any surface of your choice. The pattern may be enlarged or reduced as needed.
