

Programs--- A big, hearty thank you to Ronnie Bringle for the May project. The seashell project was lovely and fun, too.

This month we have a special seminar from Deb Bonnewell, another Big Brush. Details and sign-up can also be found on the NCDA Website, as well as in this Newsletter. The project is a beautiful gladiolus on a 12x12 canvas or surface of your choice. Best of all if you want to try water soluble oil paint, there is no palette fee! The cost of the seminar is a mere \$30.00 for members and \$35.00 for non-members. This is one seminar that is not to be missed!

Debbie is going to bring line drawings for everyone to trace on before the instructional part of the class. The size of the finished flower is 8" x 10". You should select surface that will accommodate that size with some background showing. She says to prep your piece as usual according to the type of surface you have (wood, masonite, canvas, paper mache, etc.). Then paint the whole surface with Americana Hauser Medium Green

for the background. Bring white transfer paper with your supplies. Don't forget to bring something for our Pot luck!

July will be Jeanette Seese painting brilliant colored Parrots (She did hers on a Charger type Plate)

August will be Darla Wilhite presenting a sunset done in watercolor. See photo on our website.
