Students will need a pencil, eraser, no 3 micron pen, and colored pencils or watercolors in the color you want your rooster.



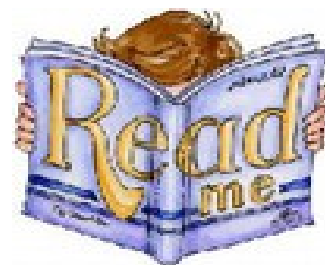

Material List for the Maureen McNaughton Project

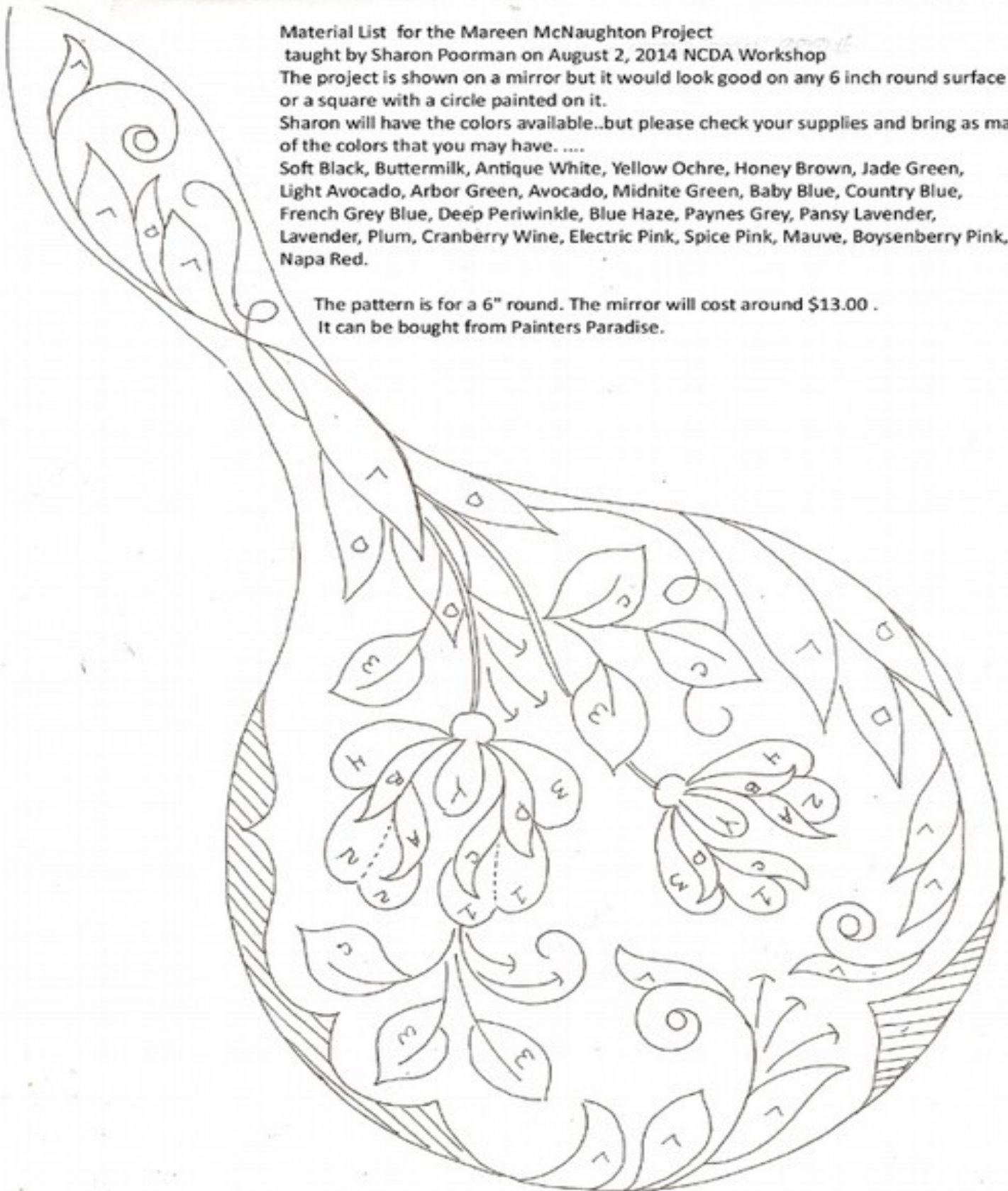
taught by Sharon Poorman on August 2, 2014 NCDA Workshop

Sharon will have the colors available...but please check your supplies and bring as many of the colors that you may have.

Soft Black, Buttermilk, Antique White, Yellow Ochre, Honey Brown, Jade Green, Light Avocado, Arbor Green, Avocado, Midnite Green, Baby Blue, Country Blue, French Grey Blue, Deep Periwinkle, Blue Haze, Paynes Grey, Pansy Lavender, Lavender, Plum, Cranberry Wine, Electric Pink, Spice Pink, Mauve, Boysenberry Pink, Napa Red.

The pattern is for a 6" round. The mirror will cost around \$13.00 .
