Enjoy the rest of the summer, hope to see you all in September. Hugs



New Business: More discussion of fund raising next year.


Show and Tell: Many beautiful art pieces were shown by Lois Owens, Pat Otto and Ronnie Bringle.

DecoArt Americana Acrylics:

Camel,

Green Tea,

Hauser Light Green,

Lamp Black,

Light Avocado,

Moon Yellow,

Persimmon,

Royal Purple,

Sable Brown,

Snow White,

Soft Black,

Spiced Pumpkin,

Warm White,

Wild Orchid

Glass

I painted on a green and sponged on an orange color.

Lamp Shade

We will base coat the outside with Camel and the inside with Persimmon. Tape 1/2 inch around the bottom and paint with Wild Orchid. We will have time to paint this in class.

Items needed:

Paint

Tape

Tracing Paper

Stylus/Pen

Sponge

Star stencil

Brushes

Palette Paper

Paper Towels

Water Container

trace Pattern (preferably on vellum)
