



Flourless Peanut Butter Chocolate Chip Cookies

....recipe from Pat Otto

1 cup natural peanut butter 1 cup brown sugar

1 egg

1 tsp vanilla

1 tsp baking soda

Cream together first 5 ingredients

3/4 cup chocolate chips

Roll into 1 1/2 inch balls and place them 2 inches apart on parchment paper covered cookie sheet.

Makes approx. 18 cookies.

Bake at 350 degrees for 8-10 minutes.

Wait 5 minutes before taking off paper.

Prep for August 31st Watercolor Light House Paper:

Arches 140 lb w/c paper. It comes in a 22x30 sheets. We will be using an 11x15 piece..best price is at Hobby Lobby. Back wall of Art department. Michaels sells it in 3 1/2 sheets per pk.for more.

See Carole if you would like to get the paper (\$5) and colors (\$5 per palette) from her.

Cerulean Blue Cobalt Blue

Turquoise (hard to find)
Paynes Grey
Yellow Ochre
Cad Red Light or Vermillion
Sepia or Sepia Umber
Alizaron Crimson
Sap Green
Permanent Rose
Diox. Purple
White Gouache

Brushes and Tools: Large Wash Brush..at least 1" 3/4 inch flat #12 round #2 script liner

OLD credit card
Sea sponge
Nylon kitchen sponge
Tooth brush
Small spray bottle
Watercolor palette with large surface
2 water containers
Cotton towel or soft (Viva or Blue) towels
Graphite paper (old is best)
Blue tape



Trace pattern on tracing paper and then transfer with graphite paper (lightly) onto w/c paper. On the bottom of the pattern there is a notation (square corner/straight edge). Use this to make sure your pattern is straight on the paper.
