Programs submitted by Pat Otto

October 3 – Linda Duff is teaching cute candle sticks made from martini or wine glasses. Bring your regular acrylic supplies and brushes plus one or two glasses to paint. Check the dollar store or Wal-Mart. You may have some glasses that have gotten cloudy or scratched from the dishwasher – they work for this. They are not for drinking out of so no special paints.

Here is the prep and material list from Linda...

2 Martini Glasses, or wine glasses, whatever you prefer.

Wash glasses and let dry. Clean with vinegar or rubbing alcohol. I put 3 coats of paint on my glasses. So if you like, do 2 coats at

home and then you can put the 3rd coat on during class. I bought the martini glasses and the first time they were the clear glass stems, this time I bought the glasses that have the green stem, so I am not going to paint the stem black, going to see what they look like with the green.

Use a sponge, or I used Donna Dewberry Pouncer to paint the coats on my glasses. If you do 2 coats that way, with the sponge or the pouncer, you can use a regular brush for the 3rd coat. I did use the Deco paint that can be used on either, (the satin I believe it's called). If you have the paint for glass you can use that, and someone said, that as long as you aren't washing the glasses, you can use the regular deco paint. So whatever kind of paint you have, you can use.

The colors for the glasses are below. Some of these colors I did not have so I used what I had, which I am sure you will too.

BlackRazzleberry for checksBright OrangeWhite for sparkle for eyesBright YellowBurnt OrangeBurnt SiennaTurquoise for eyes

Use what every colors you want for the dots on the stems and the, top part.

I will bring the black boa, and also a hot glue gun and hot glue.

I will also have some ribbon if you want to put a ribbon on it .

Also I will bring patterns for the eyes, noise and mouth if you want to use it, or you can just do your own.

November 7th- Jeanette Seese will teach an adorable snowman that she has painted on canvas and adhered to a bathroom scale, that is why there is a cut out section in the middle of the top of the design. You, as always, may paint it on any surface. For this project, canvas from a canvas pad works very well. If you choose to paint on fabric or glass you must adjust your paints accordingly. Jeanette will be teaching in acrylics. The supply list will be given out at the next meeting and be in the November newsletter.







We are looking for someone to take the 2nd VP Program Chairman position. The Program Chairman is responsible for asking teachers to submit projects to fill 8-10 slots. The decision on which projects are to be taught can be decided by the Program Chairman, the Board or the Membership. Usually the chairman contacts an outside teacher for a seminar or two, but that depends on the chapter finances and member participation. The chairman is responsible for telling the teacher how many students are signed up so that the teacher can provide the right amount of materials. The chairman usually sits with the treasurer as people come in to the meeting to give out materials and

answer questions about upcoming programs. If the chairman can't make a meeting she should ask someone to sit in for her and get the necessary information and materials to the sub. Next year there will be no 5th Saturday classes so there should be no problem filling the slots.

Please fill in all the information on the next page when paying for 2016 NCDA dues.

All members of NCDA Chapter must also be a member of the National Society of Decorative Painters. The membership year for both organizations is from January 1to December 31. There is no provision for pro-rating of dues. You can find the NSDP link on our Home Page of our website www.naturecoastdecorativeartists.com

NCDA membership dues shall be \$10 per year and shall be payable to correspond with

payment of dues to the Society of Decorative Painters (SDP).

Membership in NCDA requires \$10 annual membership in WWSC payable at time of joining NCDA or renewal. Send NCDA Chapter checks \$10 (made out to NCDA) and separate \$10 check (made out to WWSC) to the membership chairperson listed on the bottom of this form.

When making payment in person and preferring to pay cash, please bring 2 \$10 bills to help us keep better track of the separate payments.

Renewals are due October 1 and delinquent after December 31. There is a \$5 secretarial fee for members who have been taken off and have to be put back on the list.

Dues received in September or later in the current year will be for next year's membership. New members joining at this time may attend meetings and receive newsletters, and participate in chapter events, but voting privileges begin next year.

Checks must accompany this NCDA application.

Your SDP membership card or proof of payment must be presented within 3 months of join-date. You may bring a photocopy of your card, a receipt from SDP or a recent issue of the Decorative Painter with your address

attached.

Please be sure that the following form is completely filled out YEARLY to help our membership chair to keep our records up to date.
