SUNSHINE: Jeanette Seese reported all Birthday cards have been sent. SECRET SISTER: The Christmas Party will be the last gift exchange.


WAYS AND MEANS: Sharon Poorman held the raffle for several items.

No more Programs until our White Elephant Sale in January so Linda has sent you her recipe for her Famous Black Bean Soup that she made for the September Pumpkin Festival Buffet

Susan's Spicy Chicken, Black Bean, & Pumpkin Soup

8 cups low sodium chicken broth

2 chicken breasts – boil and shredded

1 onion diced

1 red bell pepper diced

3 cloves garlic

2 cans Rotel tomatoes and green chilies

1 - 4 oz. can diced green chilies

2 cans black beans, rinsed and drained

1 can 100% pure pumpkin

1½ T cumin

1 t oregano

Juice of 1 lime

2T cilantro

Puree 1 can of black beans with 1 cup of broth. Combine all ingredients and cook for at least 1 hour.

To mellow the spice .. offer a glop of Sour Cream or plain yogurt when serving!


