August 4, 2012 ... Artist's Clock with a Sunflower Theme.

Guest artist Julie Polderdyke, a nationally known teacher, will teach an adorable painting of an artist's palette on MDF board. Clock works can be attached when the surface dries, and you will have a great gift idea or decoration for your studio. Clock surfaces are still available for \$3.75, but you will need to arrive very early to prep them if you intend to use them that day.



Please bring your acrylic painting brushes, water bucket, palette, paper towels, and other items you like to use. Julie will provide the paint.

Pat lost her sister last month, so thanked everyone for the sympathy cards and prayers.







Line drawing and prep instructions for September 1st Workshop, taught by Pat Landry:

The original design was done by Mary Svenson. It can be painted on a surface of your choice on wood or MDF board.

Use acrylic paint and paint the background a light neutral color, and pick a color of your choice for the design (darker than the background).

You will need your regular painting supplies. Brushes: 3/8 or 1/2 inch angles or 8, 10 or 12 flats. You will also need a good liner.

Let's get creative and have fun with this.
