So I'll wish you all a happy Labor Day! Stay inside and keep cool, keep those paint brushes moving

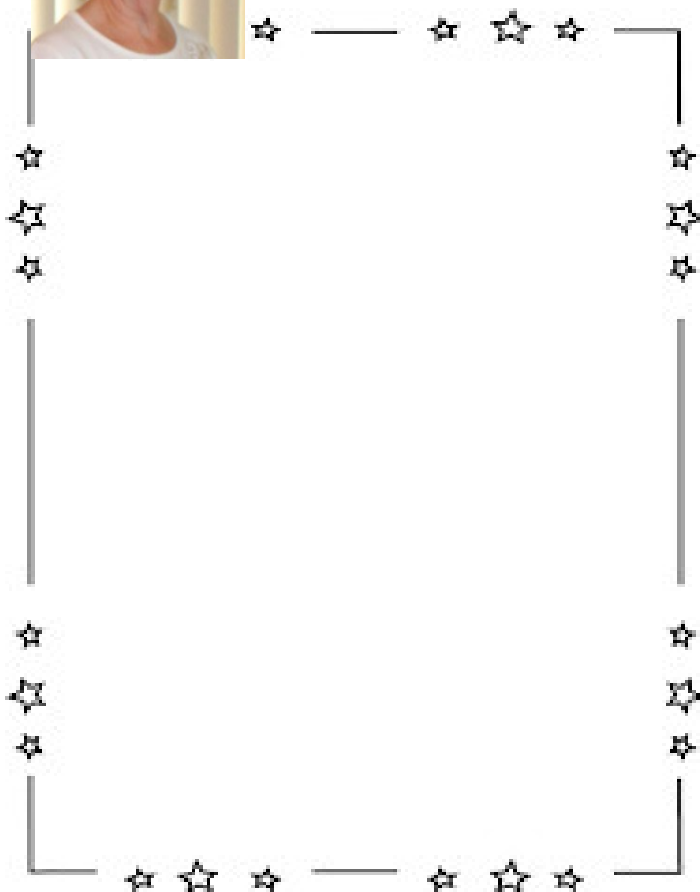

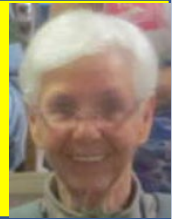
