

While painting this project, I found a couple of suggestions to help us complete as much of the project as possible. It would be helpful if you did the following:

- 1. Base coat the entire wood tree with **Light Avocado**
- 2. Transfer the pattern with white transfer paper.
- 3. Base coat all of the leaves with **Desert Cactus** using long strokes to follow the direction of the leaf. Put the pattern back on and transfer the lines for the twisted and flipped leaves.

4 Base coat the flower petals with **Scarlet**.

This pattern is available to download and print free from Artist Club. I will hand out the pattern at the Christmas Party because we had the tree enlarged and therefore our pattern had to be enlarged. We took orders for the trees at the November meeting. They are \$5.00 each. If you did not get your order in, please let me know as soon as possible.
