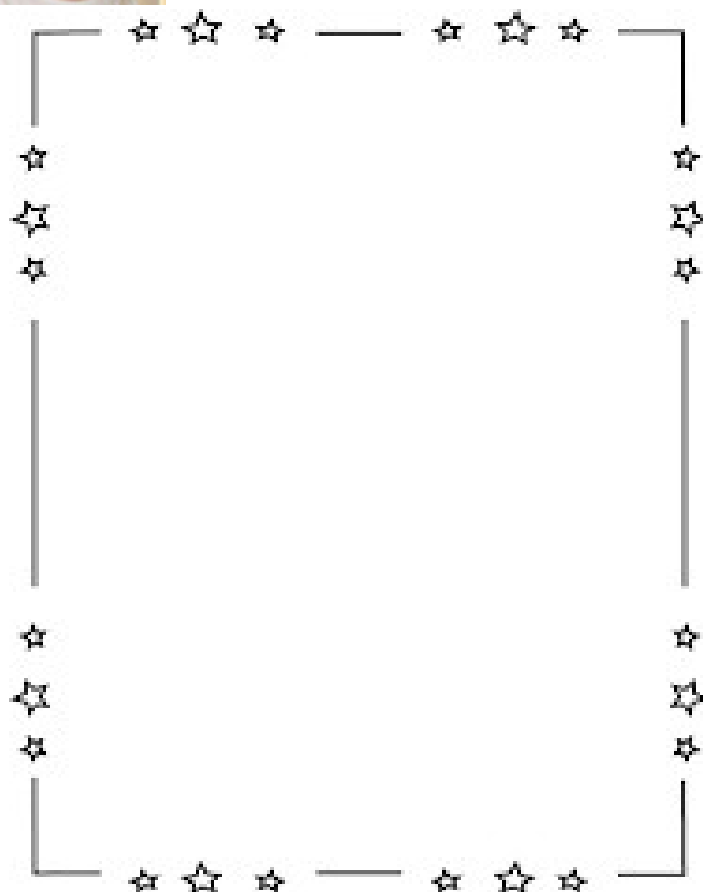

Following is the palette:

Deco Americana:

Antique White, Mink Tan or Fawn, Lamp Black,
Titanium White,
Kelly Green, Hauser Dark Green, Calico Red, Midnight
Blue,

Burgandy Wine, Antique Gold

JoSonja: Burnished Copper, Brown Earth

Brushes: #1 Liner, #3, #5 Rounds, #12, #8 Flats,
stroke work.

If painting border, please prep with Hauser Dark
Green.

Place pattern on and prep as follows:

Shamrocks - Dark Green Mix (3 chocolate chip sizes
Kelly Green, 2 chocolate chip sizes Midnight Blue and 1
chocolate chip size Lamp Black.

Birds: Wing - Kelly Green

Breast - Mink Tan or Fawn

Head - Mix of Burgandy Wine, Calico Red and a
touch of Black (We will do feathers in class).

Brush all colors smoothly!!!

Large mop, #8 Bringle Blender

Bring your other similar brushes in other
sizes as you may be more comfortable with
some of these.

Other Supplies:

White graphite paper, tracing paper, wet
palette, fine sand paper, paper towels, water
basin, palette knife, stylus, Jo Sonja
Retarder.

Surface: the inside pattern is 9" wide by 9"
long

The border is optional.

Please prep your piece with Antique White, 2
coats, sanding before and after so surface is
smooth for
