Have a great month and see you all soon!

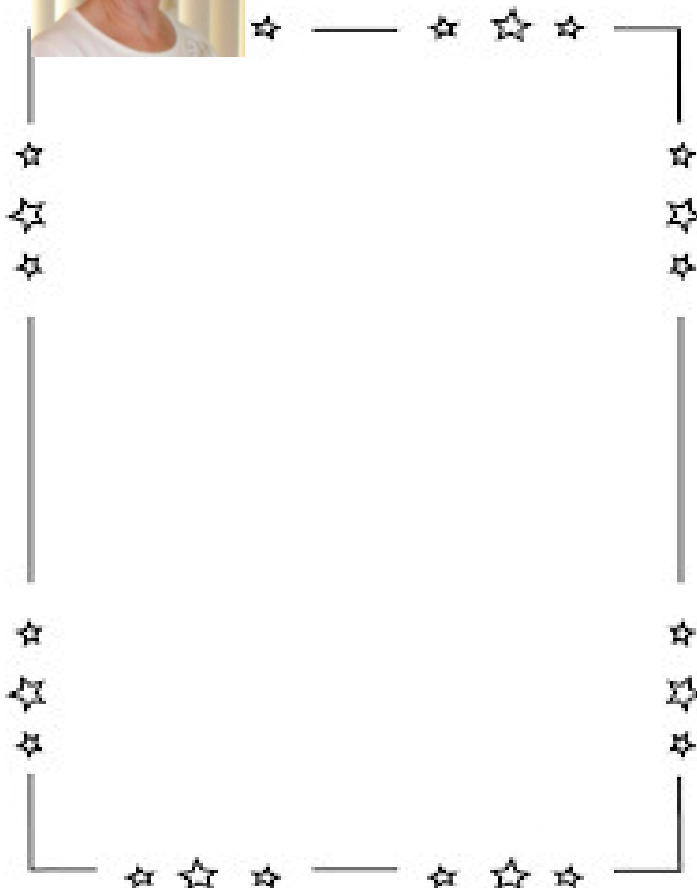

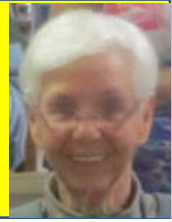

Fawn (may substitute Burlap)
 Hauser Lt Green
 Open Water (may sub Peacock Teal)
 Irish Moss
 Citron Green
 Forest Green
 Evergreen
 Burnt Sienna
 Burnt Umber
 Paynes Grey
 Black
 White

BRUSHES

Liner 0-1
 Filbert 4 or 6
 Round 1 or 2
 Flat or angle for floating 3/8 or 1/2"
 Mop for blending

BABY PARROT ORNAMENT

Design by Peggy Harris

Cadmium Yellow
 Peacock Teal
 Prussian Blue (may sub Midnight Blue)
 Any Bright Red
 Alizarin Crimson

Ornament background:
 1 part Indian Turquoise to 4 parts White

SURFACE PREP:

Basecoat the palm fronds with Hauser Lt Green.
 Basecoat the tree trunk and the base with Fawn. *TRANSFER THE PATTERN.*

PLEASE NOTE:

I will supply and basecoat the 3" baltic birch discs (1/8" thick) for the Baby Parrot ornament.
 Please feel free to bring your own ornament if you prefer.
