

painting Charming Charlie , since I never met him in person I decided to name mine, Charlie's Angel Iol. Anyway whatever you decide to name him


or her, great big thank you to Kay Wells

Ronnie Bringle will be teaching this palette knife painting.


Palette Knife Crock and Pears

Paint the canvas with Burnt Umber, covering all the white of the canvas. Any acrylic paint will be okay for this step. Trace the pattern onto the canvas.

Supplies

9" x 12" Canvas Two palette knives – as shown or similar





WITH BENT HANDLES

Heavy Body Tube acrylics - your brand - Or buy a palette from me.

Titanium White

Burnt Sienna

Ultramarine Blue

Cad Yellow Medium or Benzimidazolone Yellow Medium (Cadmium replacement)

Glazing Liquid or Airbrush Medium

Regular Acrylic Supplies, including paper towels.

SMALL containers for taking paint home.
