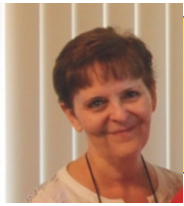

May's project is multi-media using acrylics, napkins and fabric. The surface is 11 x 14 but you will get a pattern to fit a 9 x 12 as well. The canvas or board should be white or painted white. There is no other prep. The designs will be put on as we go. Napkins and fabric will be provided at no charge, but you may bring some of your own choosing if you like.

Americana colors I used:

Black, Camel, Country Blue, Dusty Rose, Delane's Deep Shadow, Deep Midnight Blue, Milk Chocolate and White. I think some of these may be discontinued, so bring any light and dark flesh color, and light and dark blue.

Brushes: #4, #8 flat and liner. 1-1½ inch brush

Other: Pencil, Scissors, Black transfer paper, Clear matte medium (I use Utrecht) Deco-art, Mod Podge or Elmer's glue will probably work. Paper towels, extra water container and handi-wipes.

APRIL PATTERN

MY TULIP By Debbie Bonnewell Adapted by Marge Thompson

Wrapped canvas - 12 X 24 I purchased at JoAnn's or your choice if you want to do a smaller version.

Base coat canvas with gesso, dry and sand. With less expensive canvases the gesso will give you a smoother surface less hard on your brushes. Base coat background Black or any very dark color. Apply one coat and sand when dry. Apply a second coat and sand lightly, wipe with a damp paper towel to remove dust. Lightly spray once with any kind of matte or satin finish, or krylon 1311.

Trace and transfer pattern. Move bottom of pattern about 1" from bottom of canvas. If you want to extend stem with flower you may add a couple inches or leave as pattern indicates.



Brushes - #8, #10 and #12 chiesels Brushes, Mops - 3/8 or 1/2", favorite liner.

Palette - Background color,

White, Black, grey sky, 3 values of your tulip color choice. I used Diox Purple, Purple cow and lilac.

Extender - may use any brand or Maureen M. mixed extender.

Any other painting supplies you normally use. Wet palette will be helpful but not

necessary. Paper towels, water bucket, hair dryer etc
