

Or see me about ordering

You are also free to paint on the surface of your choice - small box, plaque, whatever. Just paint it Black to be ready for class

### SUPPLIES

Chalk or chalk pencil

Small #4 and Medium #6 Oval Blender (like Bringle Oval Blender)

Liner Brush

Regular Acrylic Supplies

### PAINT

I used GOLDEN HEAVY BODY but you can use any brand you like. Refer to attached paint samples. If you would like to purchase a palette of Golden Heavy Body from me for \$5, please let me know as soon as possible\*.

Paint listed in order, starting with the blue

Cerulean Blue

Sap Green

Cadmium Yellow Light

Yellow Ochre

Mars Yellow

Carbon Black

Titanium White

Cadmium Red Medium
