President's Letter



AMERICANA ACRYLICS

Moon Yellow Golden Straw Antique Gold Honey Brown Raw Sienna Light Avocado Antique Green Midnight Green

Gingerbread
Delanes Deep Shadow
Brandy Wine
Rookwood Red
Cranberry Wine
Black Plum
Charcoal Grey

SURFACE PREPARATION

Basecoat the plaque with Black Plum. Transfer the line drawing with light graphite.

I bought my plaque from Tom's Woods. He makes them for \$4.50 each. it measures 11 3/4" x 9 3/4". You can use whatever you wish.

BASECOAT

It would help if you base coated each of the chrysanthemum petals with Rookwood Red. Base coat the heart-shaped flowers with DeLane's Deep Shadow. See the diagram for details and base coat with strokes just like we will when we double-dip the colors.
